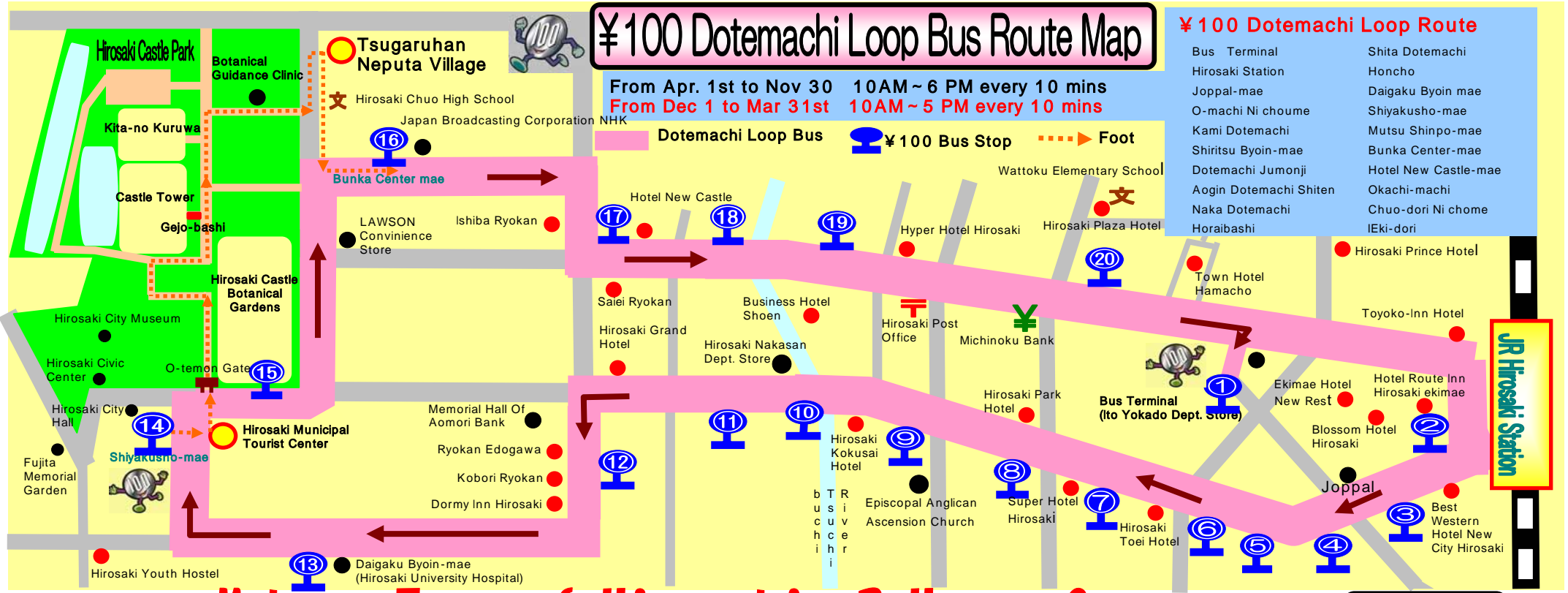


¥100 Dotemachi Loop Bus Route Map

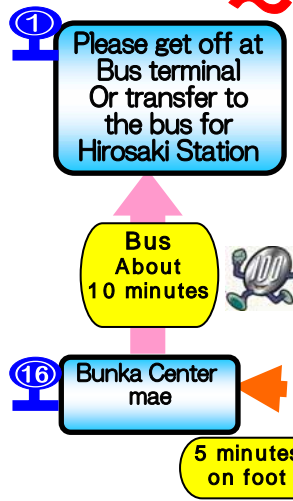

Festival Float Pavilion (Free)

There are 7 festival floats from neighborhoods in and around Hirosaki, representing festivals that have been held since the Edo period. On display, is a giant 4-meter tall drum named Joppari-Daiko

Former City Library (Free)

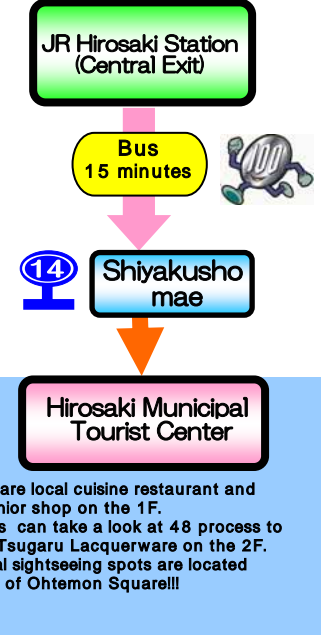
This building was erected in 1906 which has two Renaissance style towers. It was designed and constructed by Horie Sakichi.



Miniture Models of Historical Structures (Free)

Visitors can see the one-tenth scale model of the several historical buildings of Meiji era. By looking minitures, visitors can feel like a Gulliver!
